Circulate the gaming floor to provide customer service and assistance including welcoming guests as they arrive and thanking guests as they depart on behalf of your organization
Assist with keeping the environment clean (e.g. picking up used paper bingo product and empty cups, cleaning touch screens, etc.). Volunteers are encouraged to participate in any in-centre recycling programs.
Bona fide volunteers will respond to the needs of the customer whenever possible, by helping them directly or by finding a staff person who can meet their needs
